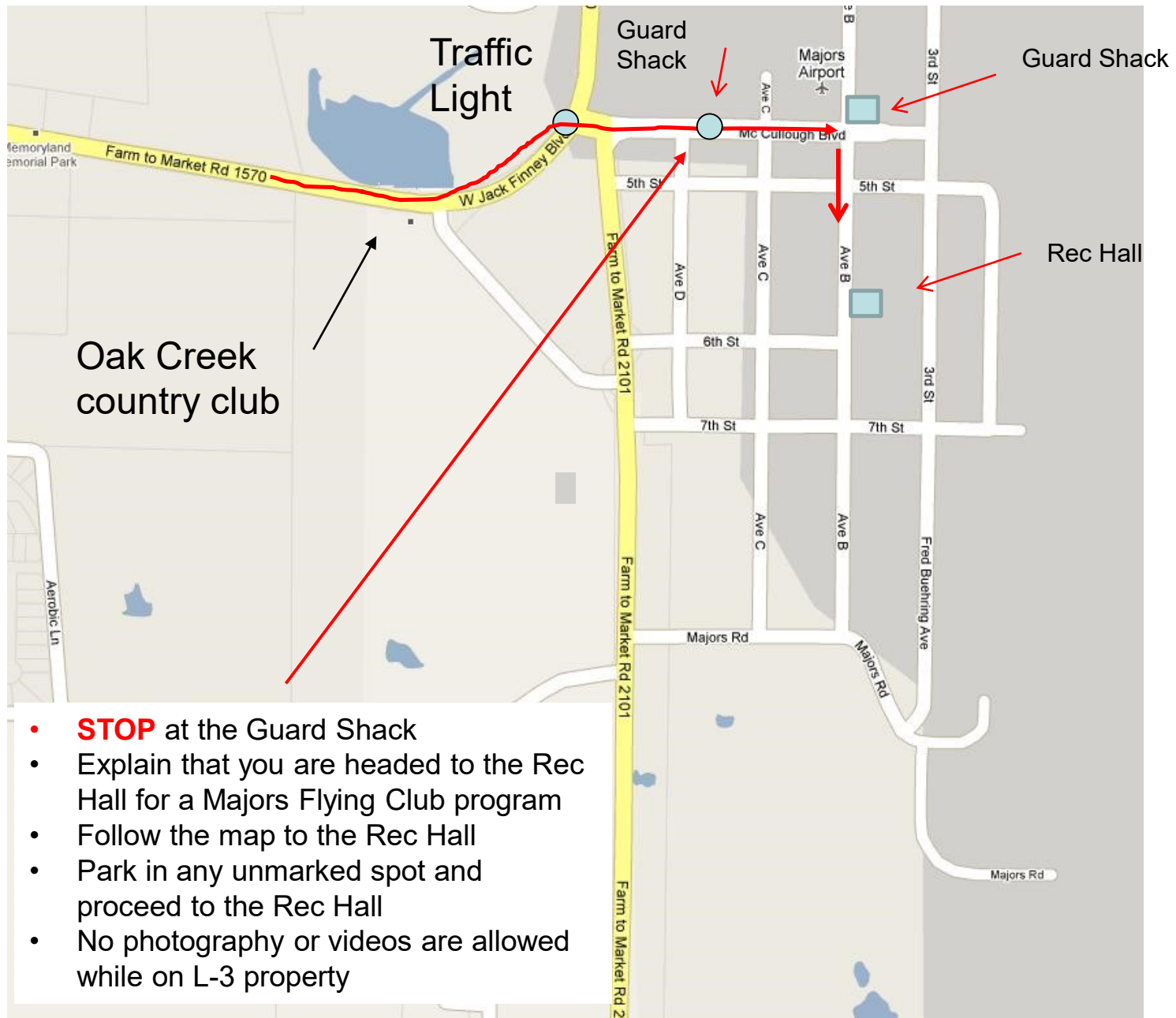
Discounted 100LL

- The first twenty (20) fly-in airplanes landing at Majors Field to attend the WINGS program will be entitled to a \$1.00 per gallon discount for up to 20 gallons of 100LL fuel pumped into their airplane by the Majors Field personnel
- You will pay the Majors Field personnel for your fuel bill and they will provide you with a receipt
- At the conclusion of the program, present your fuel receipt to the Fuel Reimbursement desk in the L-3 Rec Hall and you will be reimbursed up to a maximum of 20 gallons of gas at \$1.00 dollar per gallon
