## **Majors Field Fly Out**

We are going to try our hand at organizing periodic Majors Field Fly Out's this year. For the MFC airplanes, the round trip cost (the total number of tach hours) will be split evenly among the passengers in each plane. There are a limited number of seats between the two club airplanes and the Harvest Aviation Cherokee. If any seats are available, they will be on a first come, first serve basis. The time/date stamp on your emails will be used to build the wait list. The members of the MFC will have priority for any spare seats in MFC airplanes over non-members. As of today (02Feb17), the Archer has two seats available for the event, the Cessna may be unavailable that day, and the availability of the Cherokee for the event is unknown.

This will be the first time folks with airplanes who are not part of the Majors Flying Club will have seen this announcement. We do not know if they will offer to take passengers if they have room, but we plan to ask them. Hopefully we will have enough seats to carry everyone who wants to go.
